In order to act faithfully and responsibly in planning for gifts, and to respond quickly when gifts are received, Holy Trinity has adopted a policy to guide us.

The Thanksgiving and Memorial Gifts Committee has been established to advise donors concerning gifts. The committee, with suggestions from the Congregation Council and the congregation, identifies appropriate needs of the church that may be met through these special gifts.

Gifts may be designated for a specific approved purpose. As an alternative, relatives and friends may make undesignated gifts, in which case the family is invited to help decide how they are to be used.

Persons wishing to make special gifts to Holy Trinity or to one of the institutions or agencies of the church are encouraged to speak to the Senior Pastor or to a member of the Thanksgiving and Memorial Gifts Committee, who will be pleased to help determine how gifts may be most appropriately used by the church, to the glory of God.

#### **Bequests**


